With the launch of the Saudi Green Initiative in 2021, Saudi Arabia has reaffirmed its belief in a sustainable future for all.

The first wave of more than 60 initiatives announced under the Saudi Green Initiative (SGI)—and unveiled at the October 2021 Saudi Green Initiative Forum—represent over SAR 700 billion in investments to contribute to the growth of the green economy.
